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Patterned Muscle Activity



RT300 iFES therapy uses pulses of electrical stimulation to generate muscle contractions. It will activate muscles thousands of times during a 30 minute therapy session.

Stimulation pads will be placed on up to 12 muscle groups with stimulation settings customized for each individual. The RT300 provides spasm management in real time during sessions for safety and comfort.

The RT300 motor combined with FES, provides repetition with assistance/resistance to replace the function of weak or paralyzed muscles. The motor can facilitate arm or leg movement in a circular motion to recreate physical work in conjunction with FES-evoked muscle contractions. The motor output is measured and adjusted through smart software to stay safe, productive and progressing through each session.
